

About the Masterclass Certificate Course

The contemporary world requires a great amount of attention to the interdisciplinary study and analysis of concepts. Law and economics are two such fields that have significant global importance and exhibit an interplay that needs to be studied in order to gain insights into the dynamics of the legal system and economic principles.
