SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Research papers are invited on the above mentioned sub themes. The list of sub themes provided is not exhaustive. All submissions shall strictly adhere to the following formatting Guidelines.

- Abstract shall not exceed 200 words. Abstract contains the title of the paper, Authors details as footnotes. The submissions will be adjudged and selected purely on the basis of merit and originality by a team of experts.
- Submission of Abstract should be made to cipr2026@gmail.com

Each submission should include the following:

- Word Limit-2000-4000 Words (including foot notes)
- Font-Times New Roman, Font Size 12, Line Spacing-1.5
- Footnotes-10 Line Spacing-1
- The citation provided should either be in that followed by the Indian Law Institute (ILI) as available at: <https://www.ili.ac.in/cstyle.pdf> or in the OSCOLA style 4th edition.
- There should not be more than 15% similarity in the main content as well as less than 10% usage of Artificial Intelligence.
- The submission should be original and not simultaneously considered by any other seminar, conference, journal, chapter in a book, etc.
