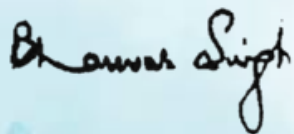

OVERVIEW

In an era defined by rapid industrial growth, environmental challenges, and an increasing emphasis on sustainable development, the relevance of Labour Laws and Environmental Protection has become more pronounced than ever. While these fields operate within distinct legal frameworks, they are inherently connected through their shared objective of ensuring dignity, equity, and long-term sustainability. The legal system, therefore, plays a crucial role in regulating workplace conditions while simultaneously safeguarding ecological balance.

Recognising the need to bridge the gap between legal theory and practical implementation, the Legal Aid Cell of Delhi Metropolitan Education (DME) is organising a two-day Legal Fest. This initiative is envisioned as a platform to promote legal awareness, encourage critical engagement, and provide participants with an opportunity to apply legal principles in real-world scenarios.

The fest is structured around key objectives, including fostering a deeper understanding of labour and environmental laws, addressing existing compliance and awareness gaps, and promoting the role of legal aid in advancing access to justice. Through thoughtfully designed competitions and interactive formats, the event seeks to cultivate essential skills such as advocacy, negotiation, problem-solving, and community-oriented thinking.

The fest will feature three major competitions: *Mock Lok Adalat*, *Legal Street Play*, and *Legal Aid Best Practices Presentation*, each tailored to engage participants in different dimensions of legal learning. These activities aim not only to enhance academic proficiency but also to instil a sense of social responsibility among future legal professionals.

By bringing together students, institutions, and communities, this initiative aspires to create a meaningful dialogue around pressing legal issues while reinforcing the importance of sustainable and rights-based approaches in contemporary governance.

OBJECTIVES

This fest is designed not merely as a platform for discussion, but as a catalyst for meaningful change. It is structured around four core objectives:

1. Critically Examining the Labour Codes

The fest seeks to analyse whether India's new Labour Codes effectively safeguard workers' rights, particularly those of migrant workers, women, and individuals in the unorganised and gig economy. It aims to question whether these reforms strengthen or dilute long-standing protections relating to dignity, livelihood, and fair wages.

2. Exploring the Link Between Environmental Compliance and Labour Safety

The programme emphasises the concept of a "*Just Transition*," recognising that environmental sustainability and workers' welfare must progress together. It will address issues such as industrial hazards, climate-related risks, and the impact of development projects on workers.

3. Addressing Barriers to Access to Justice

The fest will evaluate the effectiveness of existing labour dispute resolution mechanisms, including tribunals and legal aid systems, while identifying challenges faced by labourers in seeking justice, compensation, and protection.

4. Formulating a Charter of Recommendations

The discussions will culminate in the development of a comprehensive set of recommendations, aimed at guiding legislative, administrative, and judicial reforms to strengthen labour rights and environmental governance.
