Reserves 33% of seats for women in Lok Sabha and State Legislative Assemblies.

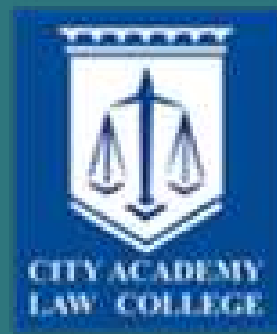
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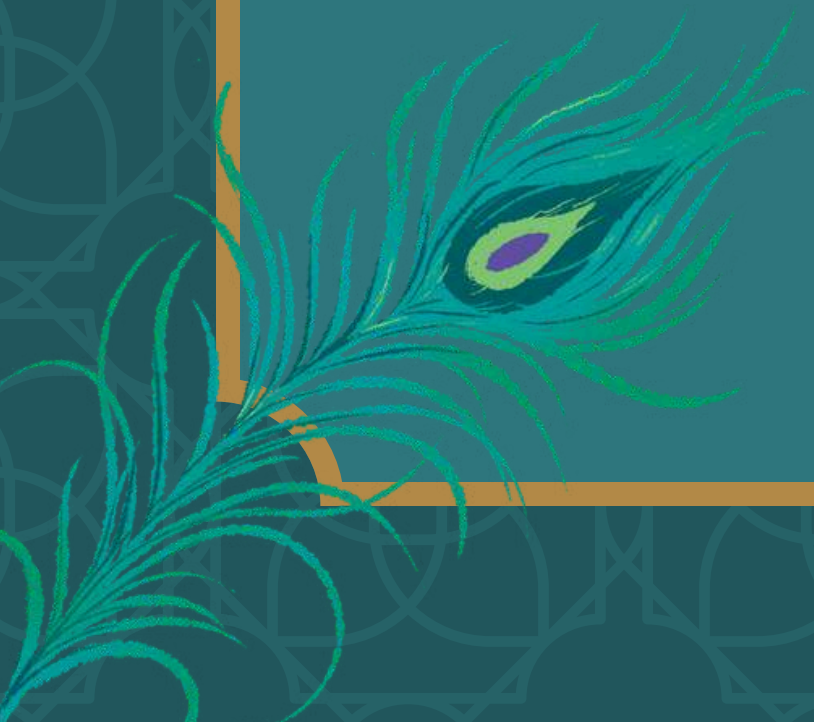

Delimitation Bill Redraws the boundaries of Lok Sabha and Assembly constituencies based on population to ensure equal representation.

Women's Reservation Bill Reserves 33% of seats in the Lok Sabha and State Assemblies for women. It will be implemented after the next delimitation based on the Census.

OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. General Conduct

- All participants must maintain discipline, decorum, and respect at all times.
- Any form of misconduct, shouting, or personal attacks will lead to disqualification.
- Parliamentary language must be used—no unparliamentary words allowed.
- Participants must listen patiently—debate is about ideas, not aggression.
- Respect the Speaker's authority at all times.
- Address all remarks to the Speaker, not directly to other members.
- Refrain from personal or religious attacks.

2. Dress Code (Mandatory)

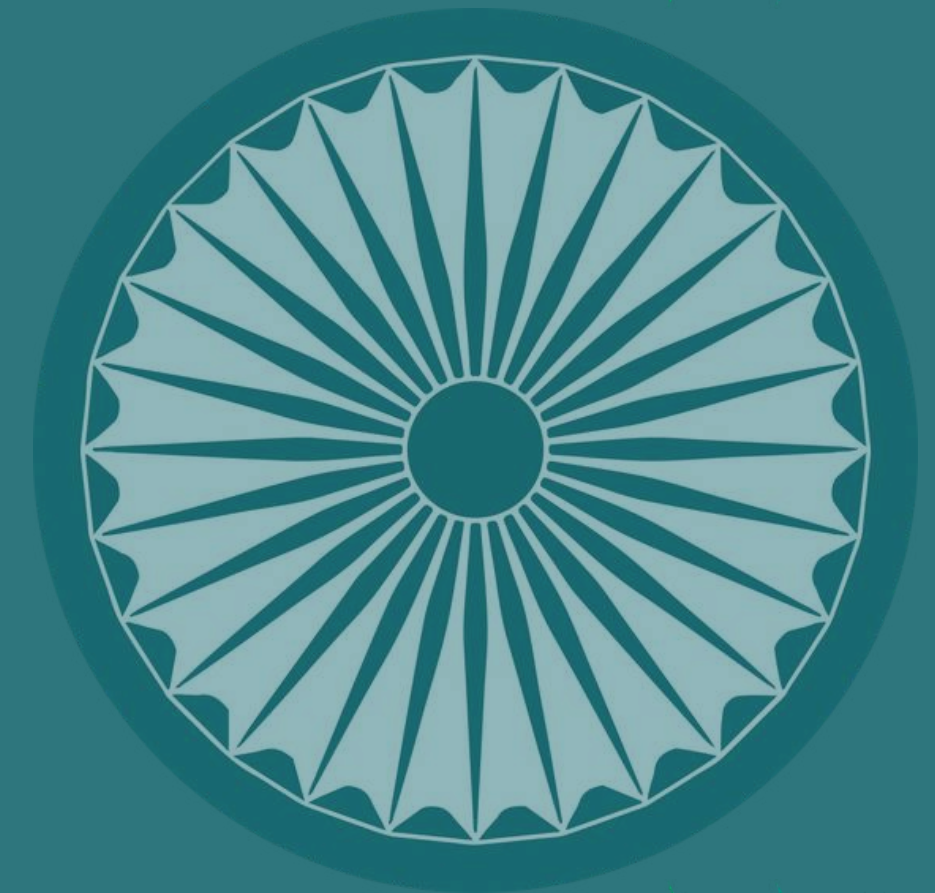
- Boys: Formal (Shirt + Trousers / Kurta)
- Girls: Formal (Kurta / Saree / Formal wear)
- No casual wear (jeans, slippers, etc.)

3. Attendance & Punctuality

- Participants must report 30 minutes before session
- Late entry may result in loss of speaking opportunity or disqualification

4. Language

- Participants may speak in Hindi or English



OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS

5. Role Discipline

- Participants must strictly act according to their assigned roles:
- Government must defend policies
- Opposition must question and challenge

6. Speaking Rules

- Speak only when recognized by the Speaker/Chair
- No interruption unless:
 - Point of Order
 - Point of Information

7. Time Limits

- Each speaker: 1–2 minutes max
- Strict time enforcement
- Extra time only at Chair's discretion

8. Parliamentary Motions Allowed

Participants may raise: (Judge decision will be final)

- Point of Order
- Right to Reply
- Motion to Extend Debate
- Motion to Close Debate

9. Voting Rules

- Decisions taken by simple majority vote
- All members must vote unless abstaining

10. Disqualification Grounds

- Indiscipline
- Offensive language
- Ignoring chair instructions
- Repeated disruption

NOTE–Judge decision will be final

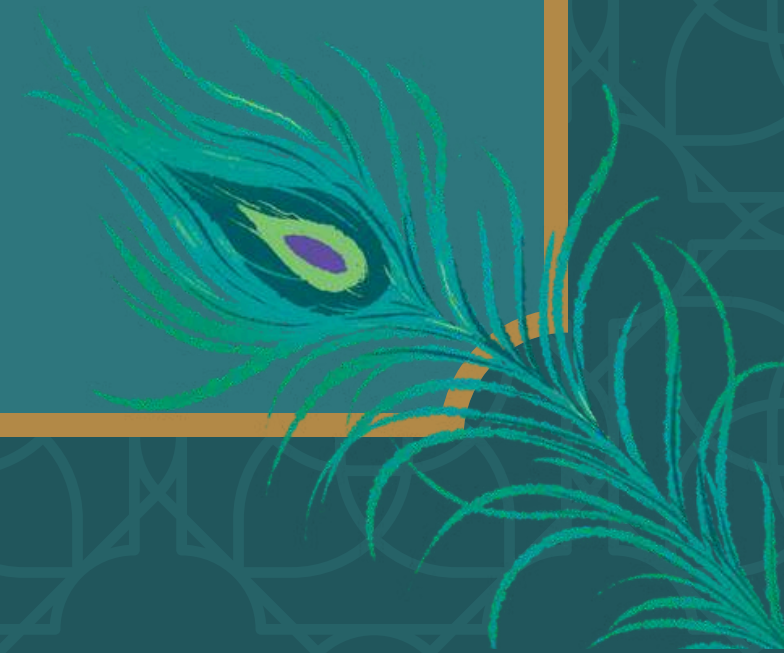

- No confusion or contradiction

5. Parliamentary Conduct (10 Marks)

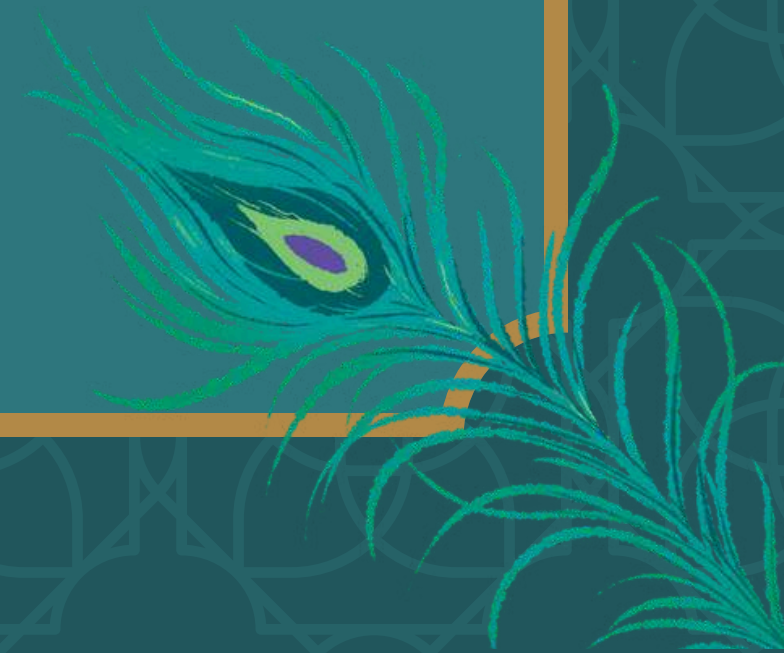
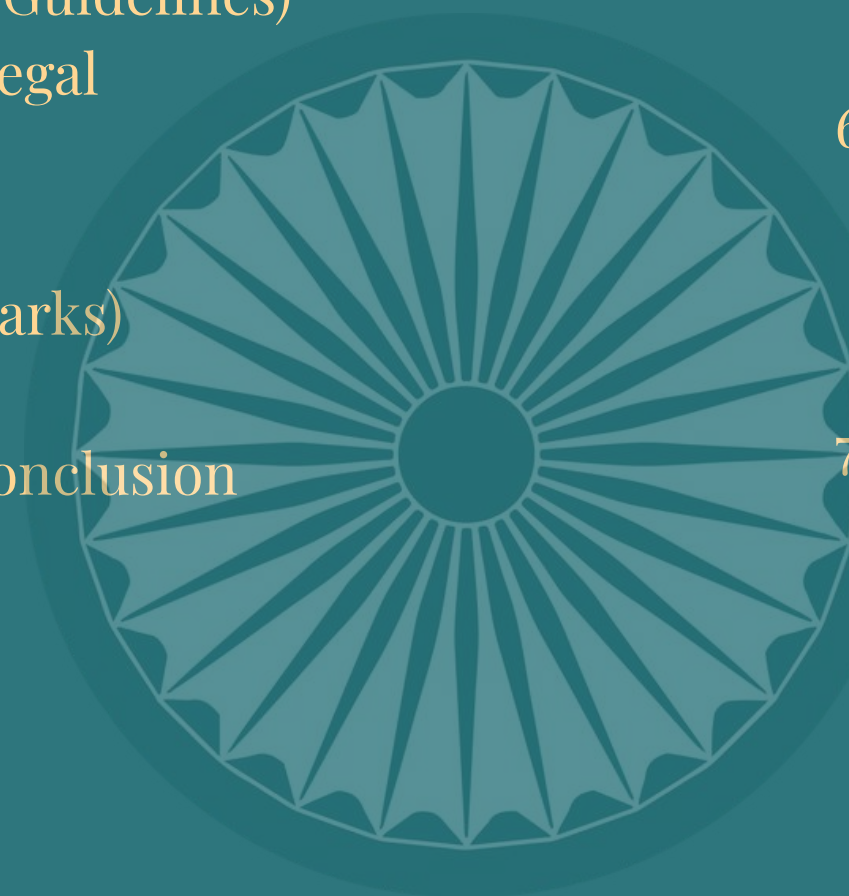
- Respect towards Chair and other members
