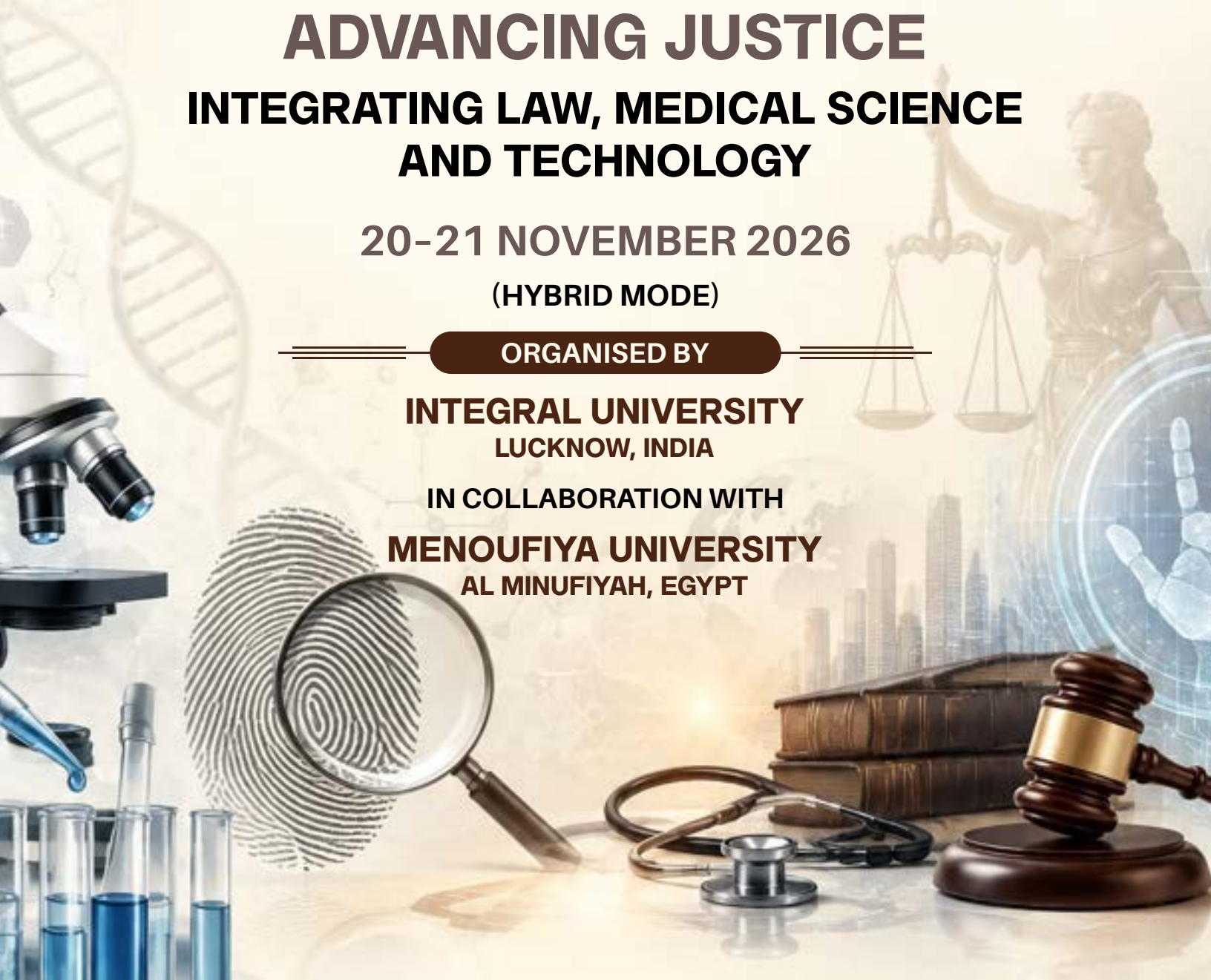

It will bring together forensic scientists, legal scholars, medical professionals, technologists, researchers, policymakers, law enforcement practitioners, academicians, and students to exchange knowledge and innovative ideas. The conference will explore developments in forensic medicine, pathology, toxicology, DNA and genetic analysis, digital and cyber forensics, artificial intelligence, deepfakes, synthetic media, biotechnology, data protection, environmental forensics, and financial forensics. Particular emphasis will be placed on the reliability, admissibility, integrity, ethics, privacy, human rights, and responsible application of forensic evidence. The conference will examine the intersection of law, medical science, and technology while addressing emerging challenges arising from scientific and technological advancement. It aligns with SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-being) through forensic medicine and public safety, SDG 4 (Quality Education) through interdisciplinary learning, research, and capacity building, and SDG 9 (Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure) through scientific and technological innovation. It further contributes to SDG 16 (Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions) by promoting credible evidence, accountability, due process, and access to justice, and SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals) by fostering collaboration among academic, legal, medical, governmental, forensic, and technological institutions. Ultimately, the conference seeks to promote responsible innovation, strengthen interdisciplinary collaboration, and advance evidence-based justice through the integration of science, technology, and law.

MAIN THEME

FORENSIC SCIENCES FOR ADVANCING JUSTICE : INTEGRATING LAW, MEDICAL SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

THEME I: LAW, JUSTICE & FORENSIC EVIDENCE

This theme examines the relationship between forensic science and legal decision-making, with particular emphasis on the reliability, admissibility and judicial evaluation of scientific evidence.

- Cross-Border Forensics, International Cooperation and Future of Forensic Justice

THEME II: MEDICAL & ALLIED SCIENCES IN FORENSIC JUSTICE

This theme explores the contribution of medicine, biology, genetics and behavioural sciences to human identification, medico-legal investigation, victim protection and justice delivery.

THEME III: TECHNOLOGY, INNOVATION & THE FUTURE OF FORENSIC SCIENCE

This theme places technology law and digital governance at the centre of contemporary forensic discourse, examining how emerging technologies are reshaping evidence, investigation and justice.

SUB-THEMES

- AI, Machine Learning and Predictive Forensics
- Digital and Cyber Forensics (Devices, Networks, Cloud and IoT)
- Social Media, Deepfakes and Synthetic Media Investigations
- Blockchain, Cryptocurrency and Financial Forensics
- Biometrics, Facial Recognition and Digital Identification
- Geospatial Tech, Drones and Smart Crime Scene Tools
- 3D Imaging, Digital Reconstruction and Virtual Crime Scenes
- Robotics, Automation and Next-Generation Crime Scene Investigation
- Digital Evidence: Integrity, Admissibility and Legal Frameworks
- Ethics, Privacy, Human Rights and International Cooperation in Forensic Technology

**** The themes are suggestive and not exhaustive. Participants may choose any suitable title or subject aligned with the conference theme, including a specific study or comparative analysis focusing on India, Egypt, or broader international perspectives.**

GUIDELINES

A. ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

1. The proposed paper must be relevant to the overall theme of the Conference. Mentioning a specific sub-theme is not mandatory.
2. Participants shall submit an original abstract of 250–300 words covering the research question/problem, central argument, proposed methodology/approach (where applicable), and expected contribution/conclusion.
3. Each abstract must include five (5) keywords.
4. Selection will be based on relevance, originality, clarity, strength of argument, academic potential, and overall contribution. The decision of the Screening/Review Committee shall be final.
5. Abstracts must be original, unpublished, and not simultaneously submitted elsewhere.

6. Plagiarism/Similarity must not exceed 10% and AI-generated content must not exceed 10%. Submissions exceeding these limits may be rejected.
7. Abstracts must be submitted exclusively through the designated Google Form in Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx) format by the prescribed deadline.
8. The Google Form submission must include Author Name(s), Institution/Organisation, Designation/Discipline/Year of Study (where applicable), E-mail, Contact Number, and Postal Address.
9. A maximum of one (1) co-author is permitted. Each participant may submit only one abstract. Abstracts must be in English.

B. FULL PAPER SUBMISSION

1. Only participants whose abstracts are selected may submit a full paper. The paper must be original, unpublished, and not under consideration elsewhere.
2. The paper must be 2,500–3,000 words, inclusive of title, author details, main text, and exclusive of the footnotes.
3. Formatting: A4 | Times New Roman | Title/Headings: 14 pt | Main Text: 12 pt | Footnotes: 10 pt | Single Spacing | Justified | Subheadings: Bold & Left-aligned.
4. Authors are encouraged to follow Bluebook (20th Edition). All references must be provided through Word footnotes; a separate bibliography is not required.
5. The final paper must include a cover page with complete author and contact details. The title shall be followed by the author's name as a byline, with a corresponding footnote mentioning designation/discipline/year of study, where applicable.
6. The full paper must substantially correspond with the accepted abstract. Any substantial change may require prior approval.
7. Full papers may be screened for 10% maximum plagiarism/similarity and 10% maximum AI-generated content. Non-compliant submissions may be rejected.
8. Selected papers may be considered for publication in the Conference Proceedings/associated academic publication, subject to editorial and publication requirements. Any applicable charges shall be borne by the author(s). Presentation does not guarantee publication.
9. Submission of an abstract/full paper constitutes acceptance of these guidelines.

C. PARTICIPANT/AUDIENCE REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

1. This registration is for participants/audience members only and does not include abstract or paper submission.
2. Participants must provide accurate and complete information in the registration form.
3. Registration must be completed through this Google Form within the prescribed deadline.
4. The registration fee, wherever applicable, must be paid as per the instructions provided by the organisers.
5. Registered participants will receive a Certificate of Participation, subject to fulfilment of the attendance requirements.
6. By submitting the form, participants agree to abide by the rules and decisions of the Organising Committee.

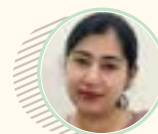
