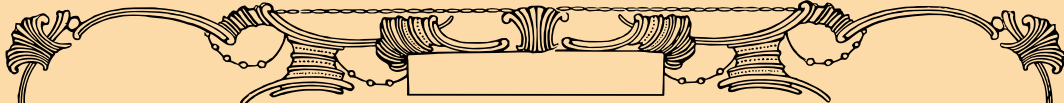
ABOUT CONFERENCE
